

TX-OK Governor Bill Bishop Announces

Dream Catcher Lapel Pin Program

The *Growth Recognition Dream Catcher Lapel Pin Program* works as follows:



A member who enrolls new members will receive one "Red Dream Catcher" lapel pin for every new member up to four enrolled. In other words, a person could have one, two, three or four "red" dream catchers at any given time.



After the member has enrolled the fifth new member, the four "Red" dream catcher pins are returned to the District Office and a "Blue Dream Catcher" lapel pin, which represents five new members, is issued. If for example a member enrolls eight new members, they would receive a "Blue" and three "Red" dream catchers, etc. Whatever the number of new members enrolled at the end of September 2010, the enrolling member will keep the lapel pins that signify the number of new members he or she has recruited for the year.

Beginning October 1, 2009:

1st thru 4th new members sponsored = **1 Red Dream Catcher lapel pin** for each

5th new member sponsored = return the 4 Red Dream Catcher lapel pins and receive the **Blue Dream Catcher lapel pin**

6th thru 9th new members sponsored = **1 Red Dream Catcher lapel pin** for each

10th new member sponsored = return the 4 Red Dream Catcher lapel pins and receive the second **Blue Dream Catcher lapel pin**

MEMBER PROGRAM ENDS SEPTEMBER 30, 2010!



The Lt. Governor of a division that charters a new club will receive a "**White Dream Catcher**" lapel pin for each new club chartered and Governor Bishop will present these pins to those Lt. Governors.

This program will be controlled from the District Office. **The only way to receive your dream catcher is to make sure the club secretary fills out the space on the Membership Information Form* that states the name of the Kiwanian who sponsored the new member and sends a copy of the form ONLY to the District office and a copy of the form to the Kiwanis Int'l office along with the new member fee (\$65).**

Pins will be mailed out to the club secretaries **monthly** for presentation.
