

## ***Extra Mile Award:***

The Past Lt. Governor's Association gives an award every year to the Kiwanian in your club who goes the Extra Mile without hoping for recognition. If you have a Kiwanian in your club who you feel goes the extra mile in the service that they give, please nominate them for this award. The winner will be recognized at the TX-OK District Convention in August and will be presented a TX-OK Foundation C. T. Bush Award.

This award is recognition for members who have never received an award from either the District or International. (If a member has purchased their own Hixon they are still eligible for this award. They are not disqualified for their generosity.)

The rules are as follows:

Please submit a letter (no more than two pages) signed by either the President of the club or by the current Lt. Governor of the division. This is a requirement. In your letter please state why you think that the person you are nominating is a good candidate for the Extra Mile Award. You may nominate your candidate for their extra service in your club or in your community or both. In the letter tell us about your candidate as well as describe all their service projects. Your letter must include your club name and your division number. Only one candidate per club is allowed. Send your letters of nomination, postmarked by April 30, 2009, to Dr. Gerald Honaker, P. O.
